New Numinous is a holistic micro school program based in Bowmanville, Ontario.

What is Holistic Education?

Holistic education is an approach to teaching that seeks to meet the needs of students beyond their academic abilities, emphasizing social and emotional health and well-being and tailoring support to each student based on their unique strengths, challenges, and individual learning style.

Students also learn how to weigh the impact of their actions on those around them, and to analyze real-world problems using critical thinking skills. While holistic education approaches have gained traction over the last several decades, the philosophy of educating the "whole child" can be traced back to ancient civilizations and is often embedded in indigenous cultures.







1) <u>Small group sizes</u>

We provide a nurturing environment for children, and facilitate one-on-one support where needed.

2) Child-paced learning

Each child has a unique learning journey which we strive to honour. We recognize that each child's pace of learning will be slightly different, and ensure that no one is left behind.

3) Holistic curricula


Inquiry-based learning

By engaging in inquiry-based learning, students learn that they play a central role in their own education. The primary job of the instructor is to facilitate each student's natural process of learning, encouraging them to explore, ask questions, try multiple approaches and share ideas with one another. Students will participate in small-group discussions, and learn primarily by doing instead of through simple rote memorization. Inquiry-based learning allows learners to develop their knowledge through hands-on experience, creative ideation and discussion.

Self-Awareness and Emotional Health

At New Numinous we provide Holistic Education for our children. To nurture the mind, body and soul of our students, each month we will be moving through the Chakras as the theme for the month. Starting off in September, we will begin with the Root Chakra, which represents whatever it is in our lives that makes us feel grounded and extends to our emotional needs of feeling safe and interconnected. Our educators will seamlessly weave the essential understandings of Literacy and Numeracy through these themes, interweaving all strands for each subject.





Our Classroom

Located in beautiful Bowmanville, Ontario, our NEW classroom located on Liberty Street borders with a beautiful park and a forest area with accessible trails and a creek. We also have the use of a spacious indoor classroom on 2 levels for both classes, and splash pads during warmer months.

Level 1 - Little Numinous Explorers

Our Little Numinous Explorer Class is a holistic micro school experience for students <u>ages 4 to 7</u>, where they can learn and explore at their own pace.

With an experienced Early Childhood Educator by their side, students in this class will have the opportunity to explore the world around them and gain a greater understanding of the interconnectedness of all things. Through inquiry-based learning, hands-on activities, and meaningful connections with the natural environment, our Little Numinous Explorer Class will provide a safe and nurturing environment for children to discover and grow.

Level 2 - Numinous Adventurers

Our Numinous Adventurers Class is an exciting and innovative learning experience for children ages 8 to 10.

Students learn at their own pace with an experienced educator providing support and guidance. This creative, hands-on approach to learning encourages natural curiosity and exploration of the world. Students are offered a broad range of topics, from science to entrepreneurship and financial literacy, to best prepare them for their future. Our goal is to create an environment where every student is valued and supported as they look to further their education and expand their knowledge.



Day Structure

Every day starts and ends with circle time, the grounding of energy to connect the children and in the mornings create a welcoming space for them to learn and empower to create a strong sense of community.

At the end of the day to allow the children to reflect on the day, and continue into their next space with grounded energy.

It is important to know that natural environments offer the best base to stimulate curiosity and all learning can be adapted to the outdoors. This is why we choose to spend as much outdoor time as we can, rain or shine.

Curriculum




New Numinous Microschool draws on methods and principles from both the Waldorf and Montessori methods in our holistic approach to education.

We teach all subjects by applying practical, relatable, real-world situations to academic concepts. We prioritize each student's unique needs and pace of learning, monitoring their progress academically, emotionally and socially. Students experience real-life interactions as they learn in small, multi-age groups. Each core subject is integrated to align with each child's unique pace and style of learning.

Our curriculum is theme and skill-based and covers seven main subjects, applying key concepts through a wide range of hands-on activities. Our aim is to help children correlate learning with play, not work!







Little Numinous Explorers

Students will engage in comprehensive, age-appropriate activities designed to stimulate creative exploration and high-quality learning. Children will learn through hands-on activities that are designed to nurture the big ideas and conceptual understanding of literacy and numeracy through inquiry, play and nature. Clear, systematic instruction is tailored to each child's needs.


Numinous Adventurers

Important Information



We are currently enrolling children ages 4 to 10.

Register as soon as you can and no later than August 25, 2023. Note: each class max capacity is 10 students. Once we go over, waitlist will be formed. School starts September 5, 2023 and ends Friday June 21, 2024.

If you have any questions in the meantime, feel free to call or email.

Once it is mutually agreed that our program is a good fit for your child, a full school year commitment is required.

If you decide to pay monthly, first and last tuition is due upon acceptance.

One-time registration fee of \$175 is required when submitting your registration.

If you are returning parent, note there will be NO space share required this year.


Options to enroll New Numinous Microschool:

FAQ

Is homeschooling legal in Canada?

Yes. Homeschooling is legal in all Canadian provinces and territories. By law, you are required to provide your child(ren) a satisfactory learning experience at your own expense. There is no funding in Ontario for homeschooling and you can not claim a fee for your homeschooling support. The government does not interfere or follow up your homeschooling, unless there is reason to believe the welfare of the child is in jeopardy.

Do I need to withdraw from the public school system in order to enroll?

Yes. In Ontario, if your child is presently in public school you will need to give the school board written notification of your intent to homeschool. Let us know if you need a copy of the letter and we will email it to you.

Can I re-enter the public school system in the future?

Yes. Homeschooling children can return to school at any point in time. The Ontario Education Act allows for you to start homeschooling anytime and also to return to the school system at any time during the school year. If your child is returning to elementary school, they would most likely place by age. If they are returning at the high school level, there may be a placement test.



FAQ - continued

What are your hygiene and safety protocols?

Our hygiene protocols include environmental cleaning and disinfection, hand hygiene practices, risk reduction methods for washrooms.

Safety is a top priority at New Numinous Microschool! Educators are required to adhere to all safety requirements and student confidentiality by keeping students' information private.

Educators have CPR and first aid certifications, as well as background checks done. Educators are trained to create a safe and supportive learning environment where students can come as they are and enjoy an incredible educational experience.

Does your curriculum meet the standard for Ontario's education curriculum?

We are following the overall expectations of the literacy and numeracy Ontario Curriculum. We are seamlessly weaving the big ideas, and conceptual understandings through nature, play and inquiry (child led experiences).

Will you be issuing report cards/progress reports?

We support documenting the unique learning journey of each individual child through observations and conversations. Parents will be receiving communication through photos and written anecdotal notes weekly to witness the progression of their child's learning journey.
